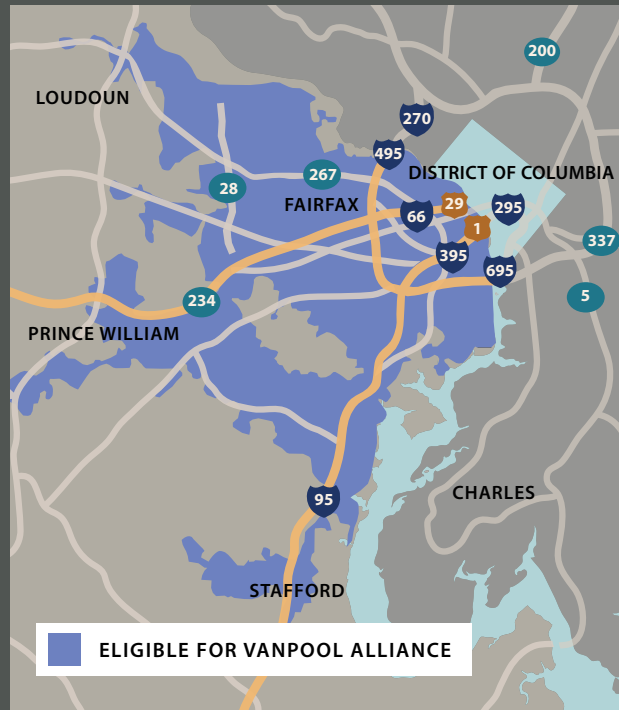

who qualifies?

All 7-15 passenger vanpools that start from, travel through, or terminate in the Northern Virginia Region (see map), are open to the general public and not currently participating in a vanpool incentive program other than Virginia's VanSave or VanStart programs.

Join our public-private partnership and enhance commuter travel options!
Receive \$200 / month per vanpool for providing ongoing monthly information.

We're accepting applications for new and existing vanpools that originate or complete travel in the Northern Virginia Region.

Help with Congestion / Traffic Challenges

Census bureau data shows that the DC region has some of the most challenging congestion nationally. 228,000 DC area residents are considered "mega-commuters" - living more than 50 miles / 90 minutes away from their work. On average, a DC commuter pays \$1398 / year additionally in gas / maintenance.
